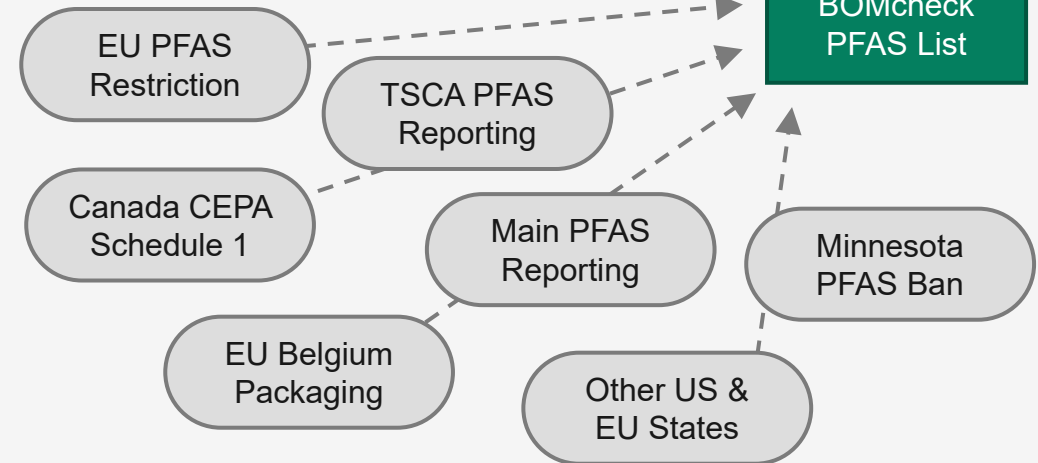


IEC 62474 provides requirements for material declarations for the electronics industry

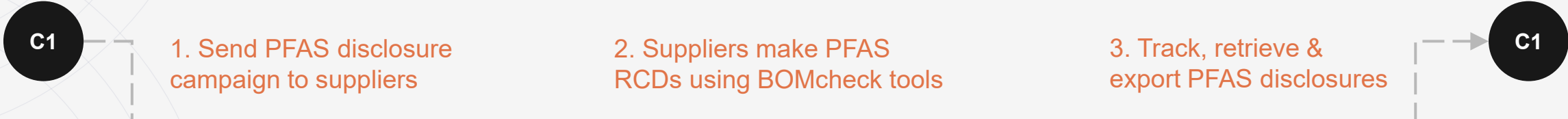
List Curation

BOMcheck PFAS Regulatory Tracker feeds into SubCo/SteerCo. Procure CAS based PFAS lists for emerging regulations

GAP, occurrence and screening assessments:

- Add ~15 commonly occurring PFAS substances per version release (BOMcheck parts DB assessment)
- Screen out substances not found in articles
- Remove substances already in BOMcheck (optional)

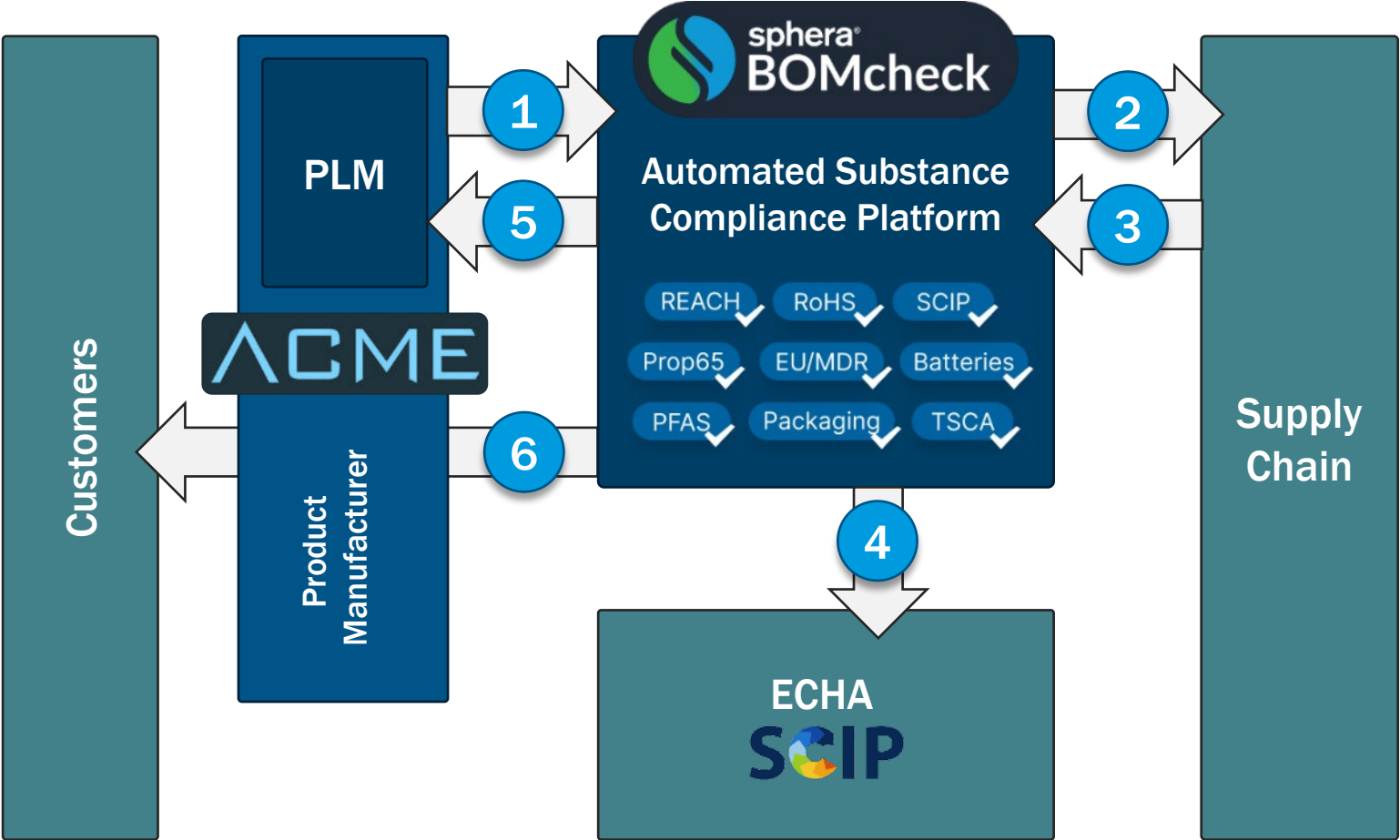

Automated Substance Compliance Process



1	Manual (UI) or programmatic (API) launch invitations and supplier declaration request campaigns
2	Invitation and part declaration requests sent to suppliers with supply-chain cascade to reach OG supplier
3	Suppliers make or send declarations into compliance platform via manual (UI) or programmatic (API) upload
4	Any product assemblies which contain parts with an SVHC are automatically sent to ECHA SCIP database via S2S
5	All compliance data from parts and assemblies available manually (UI) with analytics or programmatically (API)
6	Compliance data made available securely for customers with IP confidentiality preserved (UI & API)

Available & Future Functionality

There are three main features, plus supporting data which users may interact with via the Platform API:

- 1. Submit Supplier Requests:** Launch Send Requests to Suppliers campaigns to collect compliance data from suppliers as per the BOMcheck [Supply Chain Tools](#) (via XML Upload).
 - 2. Submit Compliance Declarations:** Create RCDs and FMDs in the platform against the supported Declarable Substance Lists as per the BOMcheck [Declaration Tools](#) (via XML Upload).
 - 3. Download Declarations:** Download and consume supplier compliance declarations (RCDs and FMDs) as per the BOMcheck [Retrieve Data Tools](#) (via XML Download).
- & **Download Integration Data:** Download a range of integration data including supported BOMcheck Substance and Exemption Lists, Lists of Suppliers, DUNs/CAS numbers etc. (via XML Download).

Challenge 3: SCIP Compliance Obligations



How do OEMs identify where SVHCs occur within their product articles, across complex supply chains and ensure this data is submitted to SCIP correctly?

- **What?**
 - ECHA **SCIP** = **S**ubstances of **C**oncern **i**n **P**roducts
 - From Jan 2021, companies in EU must report info to the SCIP database for articles/complex objects (components/products) supplied in a MS that contain SVHC above 0.1% w/w per article
 - **SVHC** = Substance of Very High Concern listed on REACH Candidate List
- **Who?**
 - ALL companies in the supply chain (Producer, Assembler, Distributor/reseller)
 - Need Legal Entity in Member State (MS) to be able to register
- **How?**
 - Provisions are outlined in Waste Framework Directive implemented at MS level
 - ECHA gives three submission-options...
